## LONDON BASED FULL-TIME and PART-TIME FOUNDATION DEGREE IN ARTS (FDA) Montessori Early Childhood Practice

### Registration Fee

On registration all full-time and part-time students who are UK and EU nationals pay a non-refundable fee of £100 and a £500 deposit which is refundable against the final instalment of fees.

Foreign nationals are required to pay the registration fee of £100, the deposit of £500 and the first year's tuition fees upon acceptance on the course. The deposit is refundable against the final instalment of fees. The deposit and fees paid are refundable in the event of student visa not being granted by the UK Border Agency (UK BA).

**IMPORTANT: Prospective students are advised to pay particular attention to the terms and conditions on the registration form before forwarding their registration form and fee. If necessary, students should discuss their requirements with the Registrar.**

### Methods of Payment

Students can benefit from discounted full-time or part-time course fees if they pay for the course in full before the start of their study. Alternatively they can pay in instalments.
