The Links to the EYFS will be discussed.</p>
<p>Thursday 26th November 2020</p> <p>Education of the Senses 1 – workshop seminar RW4/4</p> <p>Delivered by TBD</p>	<p>10:00am-5:00pm</p> <p>The session will start with an introduction to the Sensorial area, looking at its place and importance within the Montessori early years curriculum. It will focus on the exploration of shapes – including the materials for the Visual Discrimination of Dimension, the Colour Boxes, the Geometric Solids and other Stereognostic activities. The exploration of weight, taste and smell will be discussed.</p>
